Redshirt Apache Ladies Basketball Program Description

The developmental team will consist of students who would like to play women's basketball for Tyler Junior College. The redshirt team **will not** practice with the intercollegiate women's basketball team but will develop skills needed for future basketball opportunities at the collegiate level. The practice will be supervised by the assistant women's basketball coach. The possibility does exist that some of the developmental players may be promoted to the intercollegiate team during the fall or spring semester.

The class will consist of individual and group basketball drills, along with strength and conditioning.

The factors for selecting the intercollegiate team are as follows:

- **Academic performance**
- **Work ethic**
- **Athletic ability**
- **Citizenship**

The assistant and the head coach will determine if a student meets the requirements in all four areas to be invited to join the intercollegiate team.

There is NO GUARANTEE that you will at any time while at TJC practice with the intercollegiate team or be given a scholarship. This program offers you the OPPORTUNITY to continue to play basketball and better your basketball skills thus.

Requirements:

- Official high school transcript (with date of graduation posted!) on file with our admissions office
- Proof of insurance paid throughout the 2001-2002 year
- Physical exam by your doctor
- If promoted to intercollegiate team a drug test will be administered prior to working out with the team
- You and your guardian must sign and return the "Developmental Apache Ladies Basketball Player Agreement Form"

Procedure for enrolling:

- Contact women's basketball office (903)-510-2316 after enrolling at TJC.
- Complete "admissions application." You may contact the admissions office at 903-510-2398
- Complete the "residence hall application" and return it with a \$150 deposit to reserve your room (you may get deposit back if you decide to not attend TJC). The dorm will be filled in the early part of **May**. You may contact the residential operations office at 903-510-2345.
- Attend earliest possible "summer orientation" to insure that you can get enrolled for fall 2001. You may find the date and time for summer orientation by contacting the admissions office.
- When enrolling, register for the following classes to join the redshirt team:

- Complete and return the "2001-2002 Apache Ladies Basketball Redshirt Agreement Form."
